

- 25/26 /1 **PRESENT** - Cllrs Charlesworth (in the Chair), Heale, Gowing, Vine and Welch.
- 25/26 /2 **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** - none.
- 25/26 /3 **ALSO PRESENT** - SCllr Munt and 3 members of the public.
- 25/26 /4 **IN ATTENDANCE** - The Clerk to the Council.
- 25/26 /5 **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST** - none.

- 25/26 /11 **HIGHWAYS & FLOODING** -
- a Speed Indicator Device (SID) - Now in its east end of the village location. Figures for the year in the previous position were given to the meeting. Vehicles are logged on approach and also on leaving the SID. Cllr Charlesworth was given permission to purchase a suitable padlock to secure the SID.
 - b Chandlers Lane/Holywell Road bend - no update.
 - c Flooding - to be removed from agenda.
 - d Nidon Lane - no update.
 - e Broadmead Lane and Pillar Barn - It was understood that the field bordering Broadmead Lane may have been sold.
 - f Problems arising and any other highway matters - the 30mph sign will be seen to. The previously promised additional signage for the village is also due to happen in the reasonably near future.

- a 26/25/00002 - Outline application - White House, Broadway - 1 detached dwelling house - no update.
